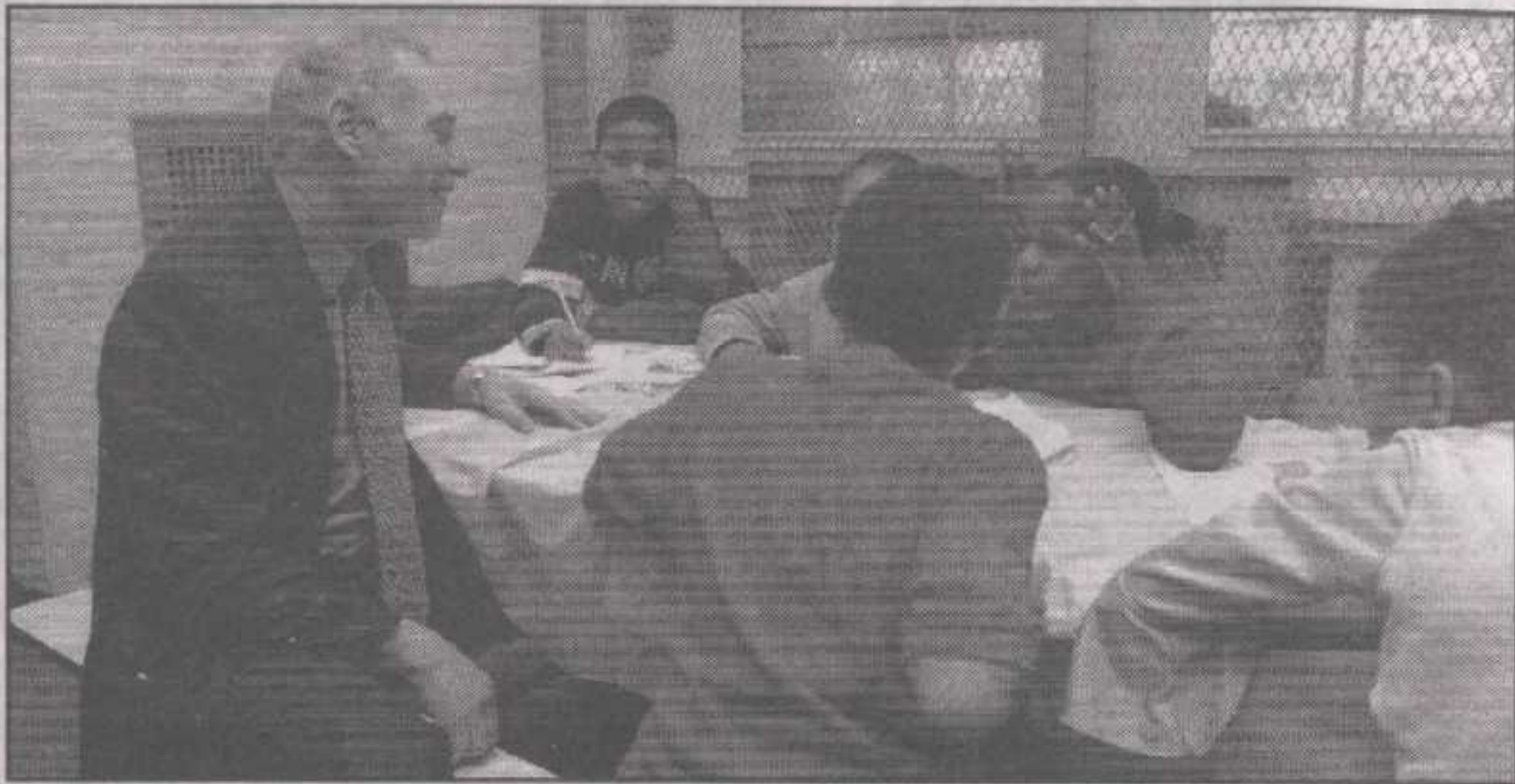

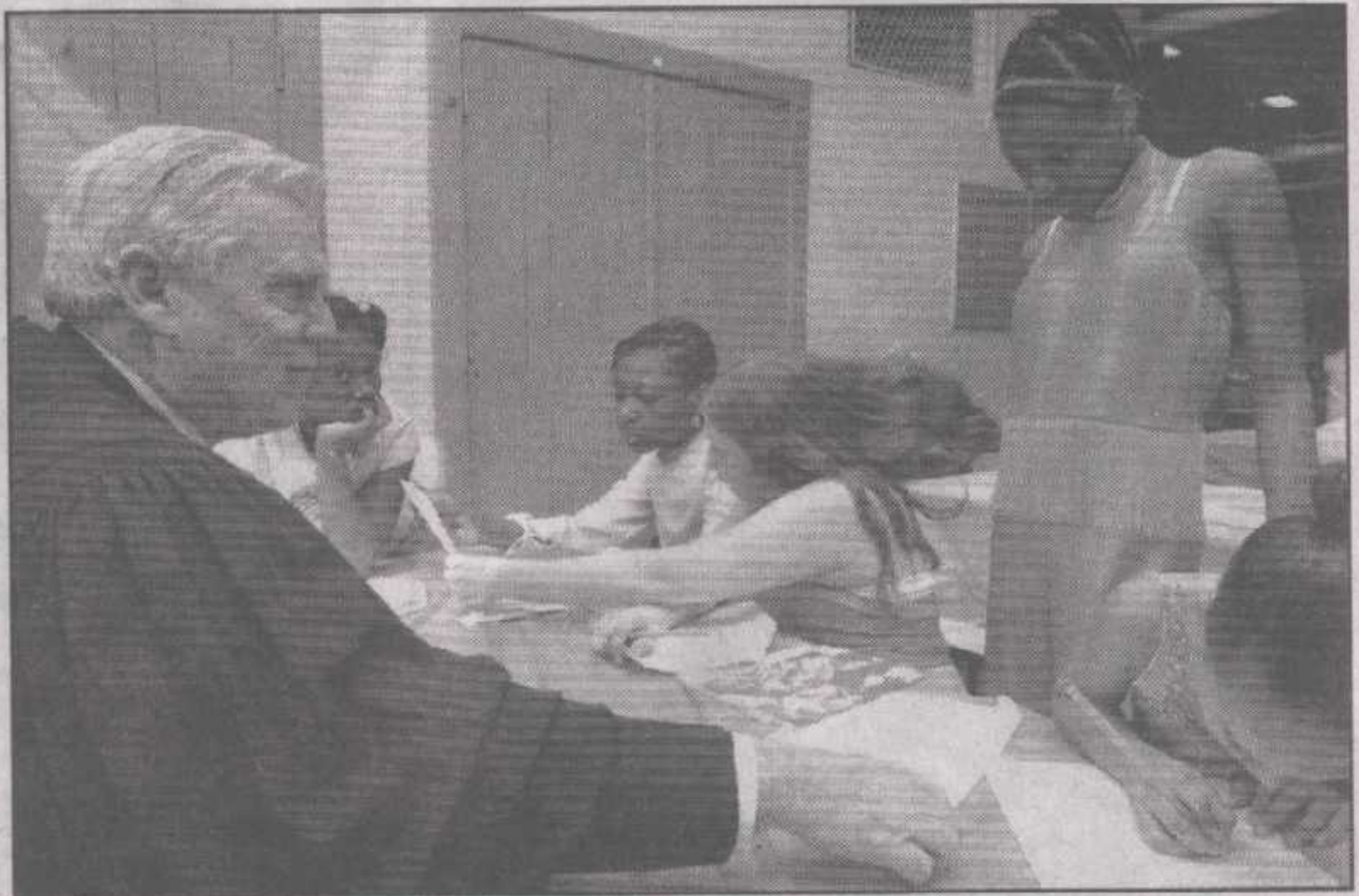


Commercial diver Gene Ritter shows youngsters some of the equipment he uses for dives in the East and Hudson rivers.
